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BRONX RIVER PARKWAY CLOSURES NEXT WEEK FROM YONKERS TO WHITE PLAINS Work is part of the Crane Road Bridge Replacement Project

Motorists are advised that there will be midday and night closures on the Bronx River Parkway from Yonkers to White Plains as part of the Crane Road Bridge Replacement Project next week, weather permitting.

Northbound parkway midday closures from Monday, April 21 through Friday, April 25:

There will be limited access to **northbound Bronx River Parkway from the Sprain Brook Parkway in Yonkers to the Westchester County Center (Exit 22) in White Plains weekdays starting Monday, April 21 and continuing through Friday, April 25 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

- Northbound Bronx River Parkway traffic in Yonkers (six lane section of the parkway) will not have access to the four lane northbound Bronx River Parkway and will be detoured onto the Sprain Brook Parkway, to Central Park Avenue (NY 100) to White Plains.
- Local traffic will have access to the northbound Bronx River Parkway at the following locations (between the Sprain Brook Parkway and Harney Road): Paxton Avenue, Elm Street, Scarsdale Road, Thompson Street and Leewood Drive.
- Local northbound parkway traffic will be detoured at Harney Road to Scarsdale Avenue and East Parkway and re-entering the northbound parkway at Crane Road.
- Northbound parkway will be open to traffic at Crane Road and all points north.

The southbound parkway will be open.

Closures in both directions from Friday night, April 25 to Saturday night, April 26:

Motorists are advised that **major portions of the Bronx River Parkway in both directions will be closed from the Sprain Brook Parkway in Yonkers to the Westchester County Center (Exit 22) in White Plains from Friday night, April 25 at 10 p.m. to Saturday night, April 26 at 10 p.m.**

Northbound parkway closures:

- All northbound Bronx River Parkway traffic in Yonkers (six lane section of the parkway) will be detoured onto the Sprain Brook Parkway, then to Central Park Avenue (NY 100) to White Plains.

- Local traffic will have access to the northbound Bronx River Parkway at the following locations (between the Sprain Brook Parkway and Harney Road): Paxton Avenue, Elm Street, Scarsdale Road, Thompson Street and Leewood Drive.
- Local northbound parkway traffic will be detoured at Harney Road to Scarsdale Avenue and East Parkway and re-entering the northbound parkway at Crane Road.
- Northbound parkway will be open to traffic at Crane Road and all points north.

Southbound parkway closures:

- All southbound Bronx River Parkway traffic will be detoured at the Westchester County Center (Exit 22) in White Plains onto Central Park Avenue south to the Sprain Brook Parkway.
- Entrances to southbound Bronx River Parkway at Main Street and Fenimore Road will be closed.
- Local traffic will have access to southbound Bronx River Parkway at Ardsley Road and points south.

New traffic pattern on parkway starting on Saturday night, April 26 at 10 p.m.:

Motorists are advised that a **new traffic pattern will be implemented starting on Saturday, April 26 at 10 p.m.** with Bronx River Parkway traffic shifted west onto temporary pavement and the closure of the southbound ramp to Exit 12 Crane Road.

- Southbound Bronx River Parkway ramp to Exit 12 Crane Road will be closed for 3 months reopening on July 26.
- Traffic will be detoured south on the Bronx River Parkway to Exit 10, east on Harney Road and then north onto Scarsdale Avenue (see attached graphic). Route 22 is suggested as an alternate to the Bronx River Parkway detour.
- Entrance to the northbound Bronx River Parkway at Crane Road will remain open.
- The Bronx River Parkway will continue to have one closed in each direction with traffic shifted a few feet to the west onto temporary pavement.

These closures are necessary to implement new traffic patterns to facilitate the construction of the new northbound roadway at the northern portion of the project.

Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes. Numerous variable message signs are being used to alert motorists of the upcoming closures. Please note that these closures are weather permitting and rain may cause a postponement of some elements.
