PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING TO BE HELD MAY 16 ON THE REHABILITATION OF THE ASHFORD AVENUE BRIDGE PROJECT

A public information meeting on the project to rehabilitate the Ashford Avenue Bridge will be held on **Wednesday, May 16 at 7 p.m. in the Dobbs Ferry High School auditorium, 505 Broadway, Dobbs Ferry.**

The Ashford Avenue Bridge stretches over the Saw Mill River Parkway, the South County Trailway, Elm Street in Ardsley, the New York State Thruway (I-87) and the Saw Mill River in the villages of Ardsley and Dobbs Ferry.

A presentation will be made by the Westchester County Department of Public Works and Transportation and WSP Sells, a transportation engineering design consultant firm retained by the department. They will explain why the project is needed, design alternatives, financing, the timetables and the need for temporary construction easements beneath the bridge.

Following the presentation, input from the public will be solicited.

The meeting is part of the continuing efforts by the county to encourage public input in the development of transportation projects.
